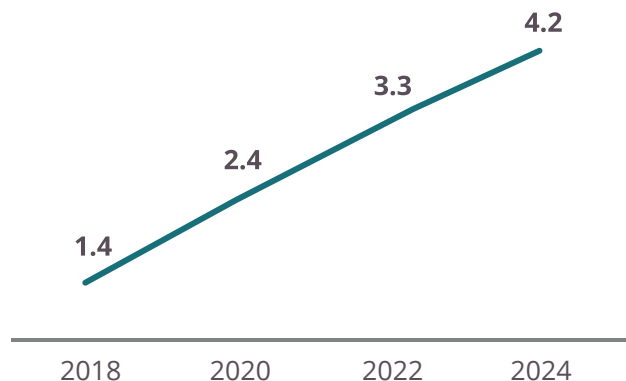


Covered California Helps Members Access Preventive Health Care

Affordable health coverage ensures that Americans can get the health care they need. In 2024, more than 1.7 million Californians accessed health care while enrolled with Covered California. From 2018 and 2024, Covered California has helped over 4.2 million people access doctors' visits, prescription medication, and other health care.

All marketplace coverage includes free preventive health care, including preventive care visits, immunizations, and screenings for conditions such as breast cancer, colorectal cancer, and diabetes.¹ These preventive care services help keep members healthy and catch health problems early. They can even save lives; early detection and treatment significantly improve survival rates for various cancers. For instance, the 5-year relative survival rate for early stage breast cancer is 99%, cervical cancer is 91%, and colon and rectal cancer is 91%.²
