AMENDMENT TO THE NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 10, CHAPTER 12, ARTICLE 4 ADOPT SECTION 6464

OVERVIEW

The Board of Directors for the California Health Benefit Exchange (hereinafter referred to as the “Exchange”) commenced the permanent rulemaking process on May 3, 2019, by providing notice to all interested parties of the proposed rulemaking. The purpose of this notice is to correct the erroneous comment period end date of June 10, 2019 that is listed on the notice to June 17, 2019.

WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

Any interested person, or his or her authorized representative, may submit written comments relevant to the proposed regulatory action to the Exchange.
