<p>1. Is signage included as part of this contract (either code/egress or wayfinding signage)?</p>	<p>The scope does not include code/egress or wayfinding signage.</p>
<p>2. Is Covered California looking for any conceptual cost estimating services?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>3. Does Covered California have workplace standards as it relates to office and workstation sizes for various employee classifications?</p>	<p>Yes.</p>
<p>4. Is there a preferred furniture vendor or manufacturer?</p>	<p>Current MSF vendor is Allsteel, and we have an office with Hogue furniture that we would look at incorporating into this location.</p>
<p>5. Will the selected designer under this contract perform design services for future design phases under a separate contract or amendment?</p>	<p>This contract can be amended as stated in the solicitation. If the scope expands beyond what is planned for in the solicitation and we cannot amend the contract, a new solicitation would have to be bid for future services.</p>
<p>6. Should we consider including an IT/AV consultant to our team?</p>	<p>The Information Technology Division does have their own IT/AV consultant for smart conferencing.</p>
<p>7. Additionally, the RFQ states the anticipated contract term is until 2025 in section 1.2, however, section 1.4 states the term is until 2023. Is 2023 the correct date?</p>	<p>See Addendum 1.</p>
