- Birth date
- California ID or driver's license for adults
- Home ZIP Code
- U.S. passport, legal resident card, certificate of citizenship or naturalization document\*\*
- Social Security number or Individual Taxpayer Identification number

#### The Affordable Care Act (ACA)

As part of the ACA, Covered California is a program where most legal residents of California and their families can compare quality health plans and choose the one that works best for their health needs and budget. The law requires that:

- Preexisting health conditions cannot prevent someone from being covered.
- Your plan cannot be canceled because you are sick or injured.
- Young adults can be covered under their parents' plan until the age of 26.
- All plans include free preventive care.



#### Am I required to have health insurance?

Most people are required by law to have health insurance or pay a tax penalty. In 2017, the penalty is \$695/adult, \$347.50/child under 18 (up to \$2,085/family) or at least 2.5% of your annual household income, whichever is higher.

#### The ABCs of HMOs, PPOs and EPOs

Most insurance companies offer three types of plans:

##### HMOs

Health Maintenance Organizations only cover medical services inside the plan's network. HMOs often require members to get a referral from their primary care doctor to see a specialist.

##### PPOs

Preferred Provider Organizations pay for medical services both inside and outside the plan's network, but members pay a higher amount of the cost for out-of-network care. No referral is required to see a specialist.

##### EPOs

Exclusive Provider Organizations generally don't cover care outside the plan's network, but members may not need a referral to see an in-network specialist.

It's important to note that not all HMOs, PPOs and EPOs are the same. Before choosing a plan, use the Shop and Compare tool at CoveredCA.com to get details like what doctors and hospitals are covered and what it will cost to see a doctor out-of-network.

\* Proof of current income of all members in the tax household, such as a recent tax return, W-2, or pay stub. A dependent's income should only be included if their income level requires them to file a tax return. A household is defined as the person who files taxes as head of household and all the dependents claimed on that person's taxes. If you don't file taxes, you can still qualify for free or low-cost insurance through Medi-Cal.

\*\* You can apply for your child even if you are not eligible. Households that include members who are not lawfully present can also apply.

# Special Enrollment

### What is special enrollment?

You can typically only enroll in a health insurance plan through Covered California during a set time called “open enrollment.” Once open enrollment ends, you can enroll or make changes to your health insurance plan only if you experienced a qualifying life event. In most cases you have 60 days from the date of the qualifying life event to enroll in a health insurance plan or change your existing plan through Covered California. If you know ahead of time when you are going to lose your health coverage, you will also have an additional 60 days to enroll *before* that date to prevent any gaps in coverage.

### Examples of qualifying life events:



Lost your health coverage



Got married



Moved outside your plan's coverage area



Had a baby



Turned 26

## Is financial help available?

Yes. Covered California is the only place that offers financial help to get health coverage. The amount of financial help depends on your household income, family size, and where you live. In general, the lower your income, the more financial help you may receive. Use the chart below to help determine if you qualify.

## When will my coverage begin?

You will need to plan ahead to avoid gaps in health coverage. It helps to know that in general, the start date for health coverage depends on the date you enroll. If you enroll by the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month, your coverage will start on the first day of the next month. If you enroll after the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the month, your health coverage will start on the first day of the second month.

## How do I enroll?

You can enroll online by visiting **CoveredCA.com**. On our website you can also find free, local, confidential help from certified enrollment representatives to help you enroll in a health plan.

If you qualify for **Medi-Cal**, you can enroll at anytime. To find out if you or someone in your family is eligible, you can apply at **CoveredCA.com** or call your county human services agency.

**When you are ready to enroll, you will need the following:**

- Number of people being enrolled (whole or partial family), including the birth date of each person
- Social Security number(s) for each family member
- Home ZIP code
- Most recent income tax filings, including dependent tax information and head of household status (if any)
- Employer and income information for everyone in your family
- Legal immigration information, such as your immigration number
- Information about your status as a member of a federally recognized tribe
- Individual identifier, such as a driver's license
